



Naugatuck Police Department Citizens Police Academy Press Release



The Naugatuck Police Department is accepting applications for the 2011 **Citizens Police Academy**. The 10-week program will commence on Monday March 28, 2011 and will meet each week from 6:00-9:00 pm at the Naugatuck Police Department. Graduation will be held on June 06, 2011. A completed application along with a photocopy of your motor vehicle operator's license must be received at the Naugatuck Police Department no later than Monday, March 14, 2011.

The Citizens Police Academy is a program that provides Naugatuck residents with a firsthand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Naugatuck Police Department.

Topics of instruction include:

Accident Investigation / DUI	Domestic Violence
Patrol Division	Use of Force
Motor Vehicle Stops	Narcotics Investigations
Police Canines	Courts / probation
Crime Scenes	Criminal Investigations
Detective Division	Course Review

*Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Naugatuck Police Officers or other recognized public safety professionals.

There is no fee for the ten-week program and any Naugatuck resident **20** years of age or older may apply. Qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the final class roster, as seating will be limited to **24** persons.

A criminal history background check will be performed on all applicants. If accepted, you will be contacted by the Naugatuck Police Department during the week of March 14, 2011.
