The Naugatuck Police Department would like to inform residents of particular traffic egress routes and delays following the Fourth of July fireworks display at Naugatuck High School. All Borough residents and celebration attendees are advised to plan accordingly.

At the conclusion of the fireworks display, which generally occurs around 9:45 pm, the following traffic patterns will be established:

- All traffic exiting Naugatuck High School must turn left onto Rubber Avenue eastbound.
- All traffic exiting Mountview Plaza onto Rubber Avenue (at the main entrance) must turn right onto Rubber Avenue, and will egress the area via Neuman Street onto Jones Road.
- All traffic exiting Mountview Plaza onto Neuman Street must turn right onto Neuman Street, and will egress the area via Field Street. (Right turns onto Millville Avenue will not be allowed).

The following delays are to be expected at the conclusion of the fireworks display:

- Westbound traffic on Rubber Avenue will be stopped at the Naugatuck High School driveway for approximately one hour.
- All vehicles parked anywhere between Naugatuck High School and Mountview Plaza will be cleared out AFTER all vehicles have exited the High School and Mountview Plaza parking lots. This delay can last up to 45 minutes.
- All vehicles attempting to enter the Rubber Avenue/Neuman Street area via Jones Road or Field Street will be delayed until the fireworks traffic clears.
